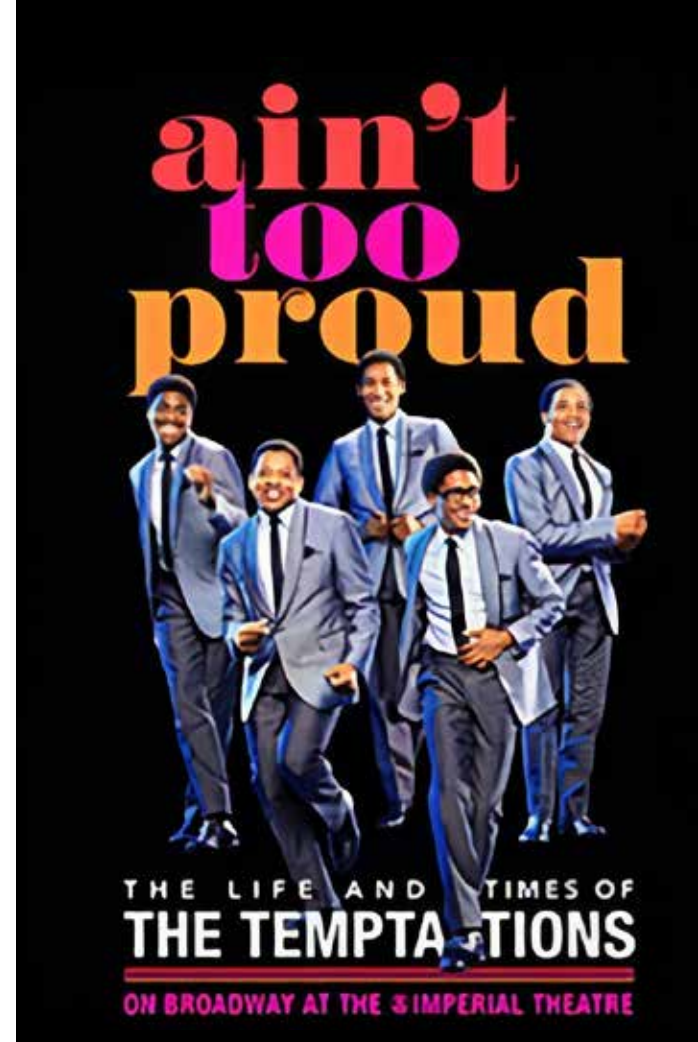
Seasoned Saints Ministry

Photography Ministry

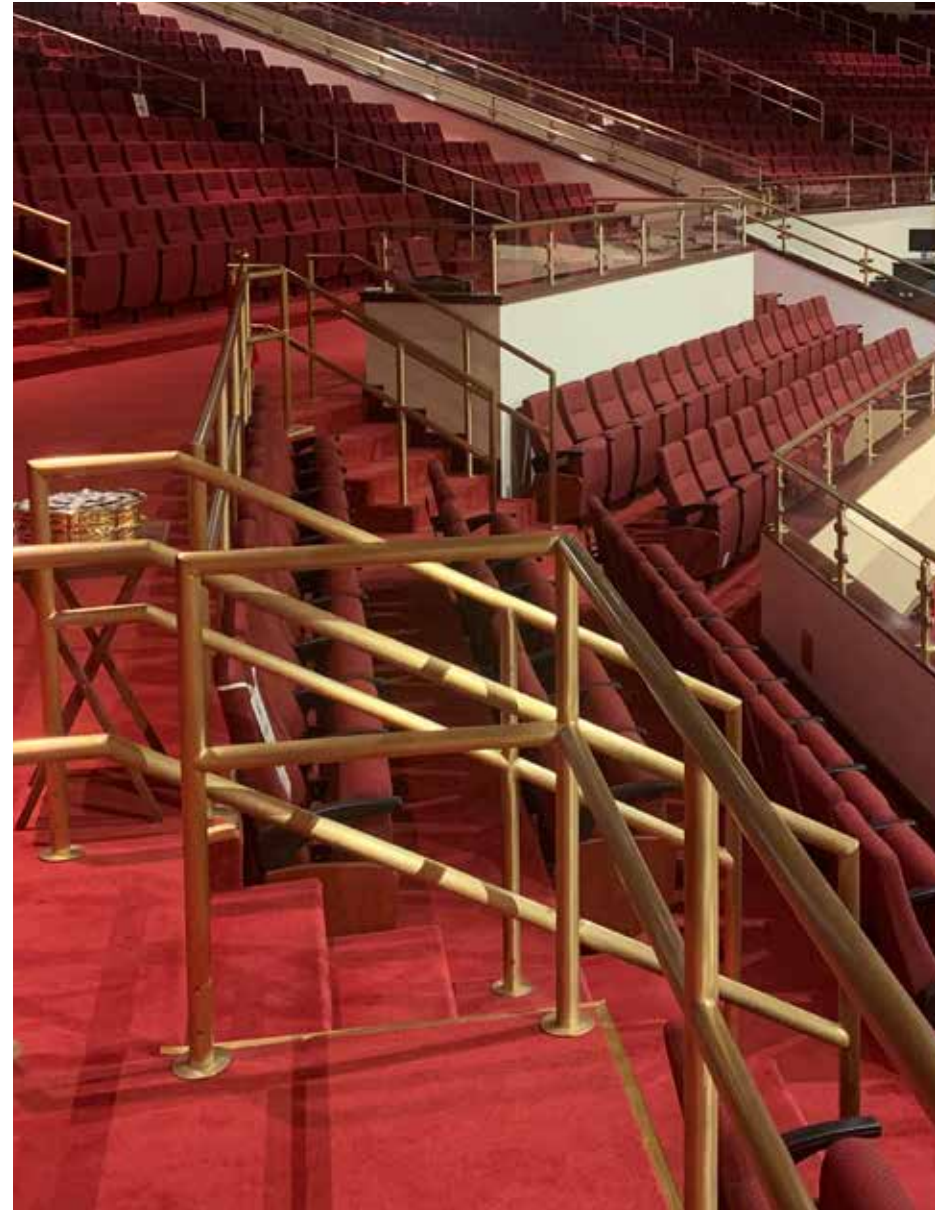
The Photography Ministry uses photography to capture activities which record and preserve Enon's rich history.

Deliverance Ministry

The Deliverance Ministry is a resource support group that provides spiritual guidance and support to individuals challenged with life threatening issues and addictions of all types (e.g., drugs, alcohol, gambling, shopping, relationships). Using the Word of God, participants focus on character building, holiness, a contrite heart, fear of God, faithfulness and obedience.

Focus is on character building, holiness, a contrite heart, fear of God, faithfulness and obedience. Participants are encouraged to attend if you struggle with all types of addiction not just drugs and alcohol, ie gambling, shopping, love addiction. Ministry meets at 7pm every 1st and 3rd Friday at Enon East. Zephaniah 3:17-20 says 17 The Lord thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing. 18 I will gather them that are sorrowful for the solemn assembly, who are of thee, to whom the reproach of it was a burden. 19 Behold, at that time I will undo all that afflict thee: and I will save her that halteth, and gather her that was driven out; and I will get them praise and fame in every land where they have been put to shame. 20 At that time will I bring you again, even in the time that I gather you: for I will make you a name and a praise among all people of the earth, when I turn back your captivity before your eyes, saith the Lord.

Alzheimer's Ministry

The Alzheimer's Ministry supports and encourages persons impacted by Alzheimer's disease and dementia to continue living vivacious and healthy lives through prayer, fellowship, healthy eating, exercise, and complete trust in the LORD. Members minister to one another biblically and emotionally via open conversations about the pain, fears, and doubts associated with cognitive deterioration.

My Brothers' Keeper Ministry

My Brothers' Keeper Ministry provides a secure spiritual environment for men of all ages to discuss and explore biblical solutions for many of the issues they face that challenge or stunt their intellectual and spiritual growth. The ministry focus includes exploring a man's (1) emotional regulation, (2) his role in marriage and family, (3) his self-image, (4) his impact on his job, church, and community and (5) his health. We believe that a man matures as he accepts and meets the challenge of responsibility for himself, his family, his church, and society. The ministry meets every Sunday during the Sunday School hour.

Dawning of a New Day Ministry

Dawning of a New Day Ministry helps women overcome cycles of domestic violence while promoting awareness and prevention through education, prayer, and Bible study.



Women Circle of Support Ministry

The Women Circle of Support Ministry provides a safe place for women over the age of 18 to talk about real life issues and to receive spiritual and moral support, encouragement, and relief as they face some of life's more difficult challenges.

Chariots Of Light Ministry

The Chariots of Light Ministry serves persons with disabilities, their families and caretakers by sharing the gospel, encouraging church membership and participation in ministries, and promoting disability awareness within the church and community.

Holy Hands Ministry

The Holy Hands Ministry provides deaf and hard-of-hearing individuals with opportunities for ministry and spiritual development, including weekly Bible study and ongoing sign language opportunities.

What Now Ministry

The What Now Ministry seeks to meet the unique needs and challenges of widows.

Sacred Sanctuary: Sexual Abuse Survivors Healing and Recovery Ministry (SAS)

The Sacred Sanctuary Ministry offers a confidential, caring, and safe environment for sexual abuse survivors to openly and freely discuss how the trauma has impacted their lives as well as ways to embrace the healing process within the redemptive context of their faith. The Sexual Abuse Survivors Healing and Recovery Ministry (SAS) is open to men and women, ages 14 and older, who have directly experienced sexual abuse and trauma. Parents of a child and partners of loved ones who have experienced sexual abuse are also welcome to participate in the Sacred Sanctuary Ministry Parents and Partners support group.

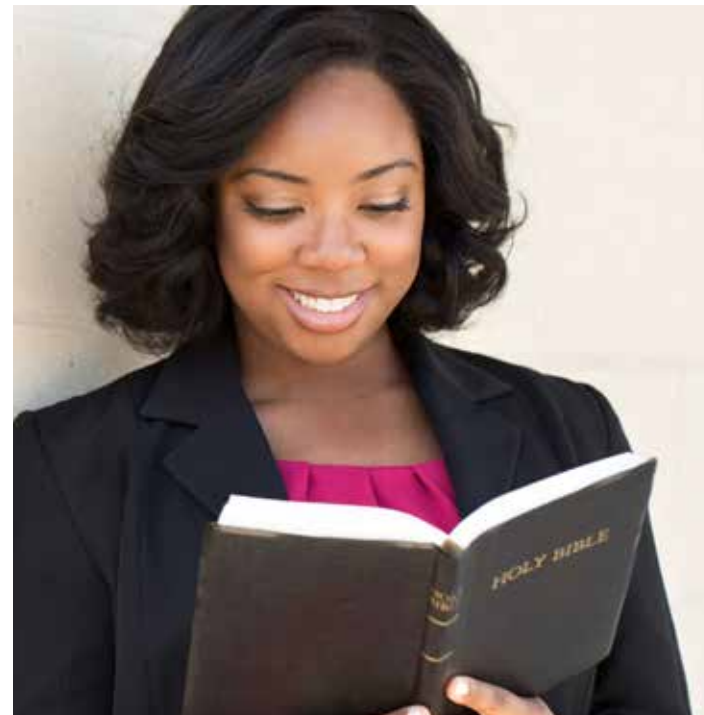
Doula Ministry

Enon's Doula Ministry offers free before (prenatal), during (birth), and after (postpartum) non-medical service, including physical, emotional, and informational support, to low-income and at-risk expectant moms. The ministry also offers prayer and encourages each mother and their partners to be confident, loving parents to their newborns.

The Where Do I Go From Here Support Ministry

The Where Do I Go From Here Support Ministry serves the needs of men and women who are separated, going through a divorce, and divorced. The ministry is a support-only ministry designed to encourage, uplift, and help participants on the road to recovery.





Enon Cancer Survivors, Supporters and Caregivers

The Cancer Survivors, Supporters and Caregivers Ministry serves persons of all ages impacted and affected by all types of cancer. Participants minister to one another biblically and emotionally via open conversations about the pain, fears and doubts associated with cancer. They also encourage and support one another to continue living vivacious and healthy lives through prayer, fellowship, healthy eating, exercise, and complete trust in the Lord.

Health Initiatives

1 Corinthians 6: 19-20 states: *What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.* Your body is your temple for the Spirit. We are called to treat our bodies with respect by obeying the Word of God, caring and nurturing our bodies to the best of our ability. Here at Enon we are several health and wellness opportunities for those who are in need of support. Some examples of our health initiatives are: Men's and Women's Know Your Numbers, Heart and Health clinics, Testing, Health and Wellness seminars, Medical Moment, Fitness classes, etc. Enon hosts events and opportunities inclusive of a holistic approach to spiritual and physical wellness such as Men Know Your Numbers and Women Know Your Numbers.

Not Easily Broken

The Not Easily Broken Marriage Enrichment Ministry offers continuous lessons to assist couples in strengthening and improving their relationship. The ministry provides practical tools and support for people at all stages of their relationship from a biblical perspective and covers topics such as love, healthy boundaries, intimacy, conflict resolution, blended families, infidelity, loyalty, respect, making connections, and finances and more.

Baby Dedications

1 Samuel 1:27-28 says: *For this child I prayed; and the Lord hath given me my petition which I asked of him: 28 Therefore also I have lent him to the Lord; as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the Lord. And he worshipped the Lord there.* We believe that each child is a unique blessing from the Lord. How fitting then that you should, like Hannah in 1 Samuel, commit this precious little life back into the hands of the Lord. This is the context for baby dedications at Enon.

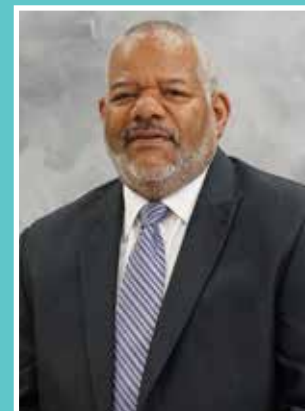

In partnership with Lott Carey, the Global Ministries comes alongside our brother and sister churches to help them identify needs, give hands-on assistance, and join them in spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ. Also, Global Ministries partners with Habitat for Humanity in building and restoring homes.

Visitation Ministry

The Visitation Ministry provides spiritual care and support to sick and shut-in congregants who are in hospitals, nursing homes/rehabilitation facilities, or at home.

Crochet Ministry

The Crochet Ministry provides various crocheted items such as blankets, lap afghans, hats, scarves, gloves, mittens, etc. to diverse populations of people, such as nursing homes, homeless, maternity wards in hospitals, etc.

Grief Support

Grief Support provides spiritual care and support to those who are experiencing grief and loss in various forms. Through support group sessions, individuals will learn the various phases of grief and how to move through them effectively in a positive manner. One-on-One Counseling is available.

PARTICIPATION COMMUNITY

The Participation Ministry (aka Athletics) oversees the Church's youth athletic programs. These programs are open to children of all ages and church membership is not required. Track and Field

Indoor, Outdoor and Cross-Country track teams are available for children ages 6-16. Practice is typically 2-3 days a week in the evening with meets taking place on the weekends.

Tee-ball/Baseball

Instructional tee-ball teaches children 5-7 the fundamentals to prepare them for baseball. Baseball teams are open to children ages 8-14 who have the opportunity to play in competitive recreation leagues around the city.

Girls Soccer

An intramural soccer program for young girls ages 6-15 helps them learn the fundamentals of the game and then move into having weekly tournament play. Some of the more advanced players eventually try out for the travel team that competes in league play against other teams throughout the region.

Basketball

Also known as Ball 4 Christ, this intramural basketball league is open to youth ages 5-13 and 14-17. Both groups partake in Bible study and mentoring in addition to court play.

Saints of Valor (SOV) Martial Arts Ministry

The SOV Ministry teaches self-defense through martial arts. While the Participation Community focuses on youth, SOV has an adult component as well.

Football

The Football Ministry caters to young boys ages 6-15. Teams play in competitive leagues against various recreation centers and athletic organizations. The older teams have opportunities to advance to regional and national playoffs around the country.

Cheerleading

The Cheer Ministry cheers on Enon's football teams, and also participates in cheer competitions locally, regionally and nationally.

Tennis

The Tennis Ministry is open to youth ages 6-15. The season consists of 2-3 ten-week sessions of instruction for beginners as well as more advanced students who wish to move on to another level.

The Girl Scouts of America organization prepares young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them Christian values and the values of the Scout Oath and Law.

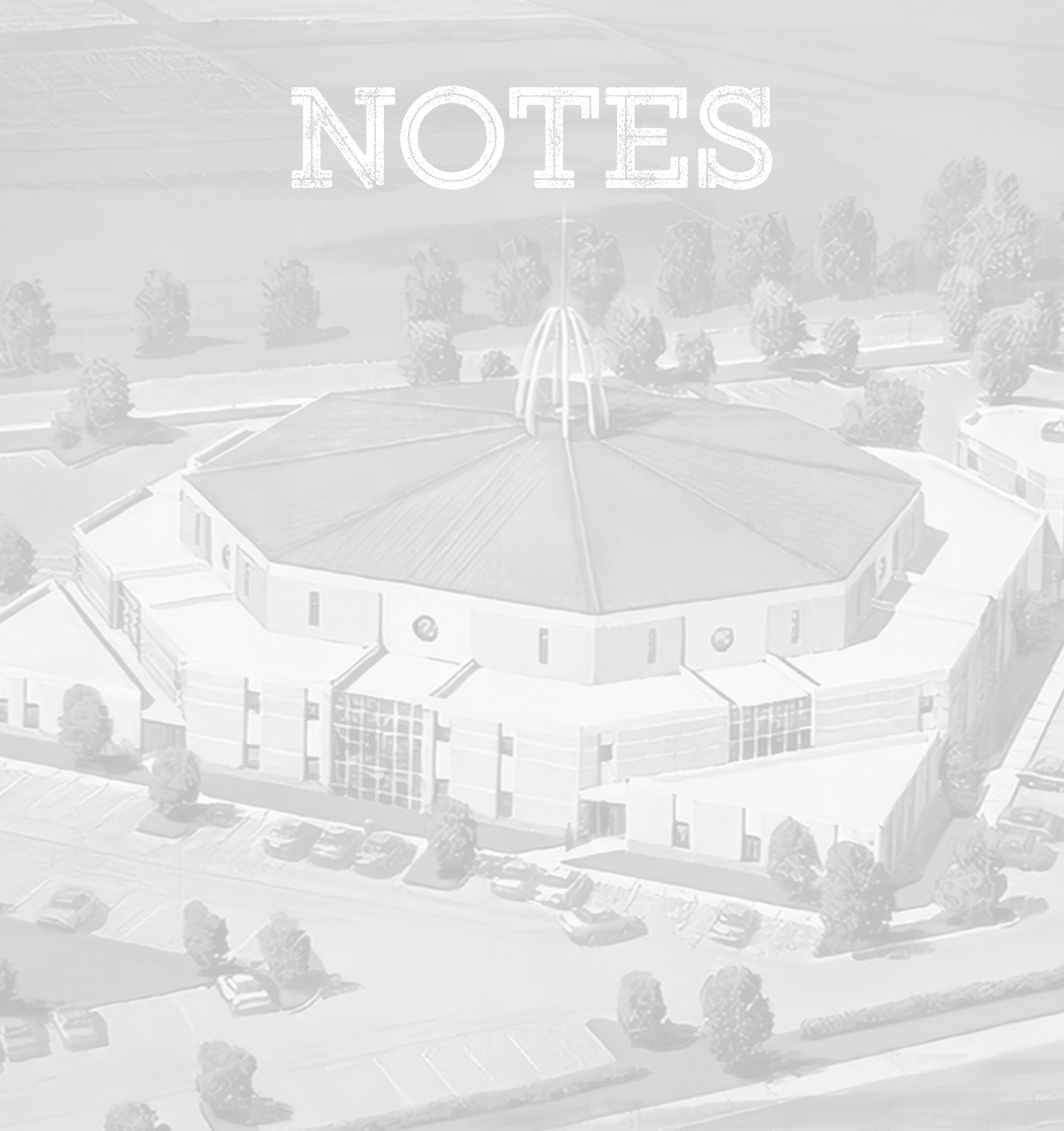
YA Fellowship
